Rules and Information

- Artwork entered must be the artist's original work on any "Earth" related topic. As this is a themed show, all submissions must include aspects dealing with the 'classical elements (e.g. Earth, Air, Fire, Water, Spirit)
- As there will be children present at this event, please keep content age appropriate.
- Any work that is considered to be plagiaristic or contain libelous content in regard to known persons and/or well-known characters will not be accepted.
- Once a piece has been entered into the Art Show, it may not be withdrawn, nor may the conditions of its sale be altered, without the permission of the Show Coordinator. Additional pieces of art work may not be entered to replace sold items.
- The artist is welcome to provide Bio-Sheets, Brochures, Business Cards, or any other easily dispersed contact information to be displayed at this Art Show.
- Lexington Bluegrass Pagan Pride "5 Elements" Art Show reserves the right to refuse any entry. The decisions of the Art Show Coordinator/Director are final.
- Spaces must be reserved in advance; day-of-show submissions are at the discretion of the Show Coordinator. Space is not definite until we have received completed reservation/release/waiver forms. All completed forms should be submitted to the Show Coordinator.
- There are no exhibition fees or commissions collected by LBPP for art sold at this event. However, donations to help fund this event in the future would be greatly appreciated.
- All submissions must be entered as either "For-Sale" or "Not-For-Sale." Works for sale must have only whole dollar amounts listed. No sales tax shall be added by LBPP. Sales involving personal checks or Credit/Debit charges will be referred directly to the artist, and will not be collected by any LBPP volunteer or representative at any time.
- All mediums are acceptable. Where feasible, art work must display the LBPP 2010 5 Elements Registration Form Label. All artwork entered must be ready for display and remain for the duration of the Art Show, unless sold or otherwise noted on the artwork's Registration Label.
- Display space is limited. Each artist is allowed to submit a maximum of 3 pieces. Two-dimensional (2D) work must be hangable. Wall or alternate hanging space will be allotted to works in the order of submission. Once hanging space is no longer available, 2D work will be lined against the lower wall of the room at floor level. Three-dimensional (3D) sculptural work must be free-standing or submitted with accompanying stand/pedestal, as well as the appropriate instructions for installation/display.
- This show is open to artists of all ages. Any art submitted by individuals under 18 may be entered so as long as it is accompanied by the appropriate release/waiver/registration forms remitted via their parent, legal representative, and/or guardian.
